- A student will not be admitted to a semester exam unless the family's tuition account is current.
- Students are to wear their school uniforms for exams.
- Teachers will inform the students in advance of needed materials for their exams (e.g. calculators, rulers, pens, etc.).
- Portions of the PE/Health exam, the Spanish semester exams, and the Choir exam will be administered during regular class periods about a week before the scheduled written portion of the exam.
- As always, cheating will be treated with significant consequences. Students must prepare well in order to do their best.
- On exam days there is no supervision before 8:15 AM or after 12:05 PM.
- When students are on campus, but not taking an exam, they *must* attend study hall in the Computer Lab (H32).
- Students are to remain in the classroom for the entire testing period (until the bell rings). After turning in the exam, a student may read another book or study for another exam.
- If a student has an excused absence during an exam, the parent/guardian must notify the Academic Vice Principal (831.724.5933 x 203; suarez@stfranchishigh.net) no later than 8:00 AM of the exam day. He will determine an alternate day and time for making up the exam.
- If a student has an unexcused absence during an exam, that student will receive a grade of zero for the exam.
- Students who notice an exam scheduling conflict must notify the Academic Vice Principal at least two weeks in advance. Exams needing to be rescheduled due to a scheduling conflict will occur at a date and time determined by the Academic Vice Principal.
