## **CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF THE ST. FRANCIS CCC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING**

1. Parking permits are to be purchased at the school office for \$20.00 for the two-semester school year. A valid driver's license, proof of liability insurance, and current registration must be presented to obtain a parking permit. Motorcycles/motorbikes will be charged the same fee as a 4-wheel vehicle. In case of a lost parking sticker, a new sticker must be purchased.
2. All vehicles parked in the school parking lots must have an appropriate parking permit properly visible and displayed at all times during the school day. A properly displayed parking permit should hang from the rear view mirror above the dashboard with the number on the permit facing the windshield.
3. Parking permits are not transferable and must be used for the vehicles for which they have been assigned. If a student uses another vehicle other than the one registered he or she must notify the office to transfer their parking permit to that vehicle.
4. Lost or stolen permits must be reported to the school office immediately. A replacement permit must be obtained (2) weeks after a permit has been reported lost.
5. Students must park their vehicle or motorcycle, in the designated student parking area, facing inward at all times while remaining within the white lines.
6. No students will be allowed access to their vehicle/motorcycle unless for authorized leaving of the campus or by expressed permission by a school employee.
7. Students and their parents understand that they are parking at their own risk. The school is not responsible for any damage or theft to any vehicle/motorcycle while it is parked on the school grounds. (Parking on the school campus is for the student's convenience but it is your choice whether to park here or not, so you are the responsible party for your vehicle.
8. The speed limit on school grounds is 5 mph.
9. Reckless driving, speeding, drag racing, peeling of tires, revving of engines or showing excessive power, or other hazardous behavior that could cause harm to pedestrians or property may be fined and possible termination of parking privileges may result, the parking fee may be lost. Repeated violations may merit suspension and possible dismissal from school.
10. Fines or school consequences may be levied for any violation of these parking regulations and may vary depending on the type of violation and its severity and/or if damage of the property is involved.
11. Parents will normally be informed when there is any violation of these regulations.
12. Any abandoned vehicles or motorcycles, or any vehicles or motorcycles, which are improperly parked, will be towed away at the owner's expense. (C.V.C. 22653D)
13. Drivers are reminded that when transporting passengers, they and their parents are liable in case of any accident. (C.V.C. 17000).
14. Trashcans are located in various areas of the parking lot. A student can be fined as on city streets and highways for littering (C.V.C. 38320). In addition, authorized student drivers will be held responsible for the behavior of their passengers, including their littering.
15. Cars parked and left unattended adjacent to red zones are subject to being towed.
