A student will not be admitted to a semester exam unless the family's tuition account is current.

Please note:

- Rooms marked with a * or ^ in the schedule above indicate combined classes.
- Students are to wear their school uniforms for exams.
- The week prior to exams, teachers will inform the students of needed materials for their exams (e.g. calculators, rulers, pens, pencils, etc.).
- The fitness portion of the PE/Health 9 semester exam and the audio portion of the Spanish semester exams will be administered during regular class periods before exam week (teachers will announce the exact days to their students). The written portion of these exams is scheduled for dismissal at 11:25 AM.
- As always, cheating will be treated with significant consequences. Students must prepare well in order to do their best.
- On exam days there is no supervision before 8:15 AM or after noon.
- When students are on campus, but not taking an exam, they must attend study hall in the Computer Lab (H32).
- Students are to remain in the classroom for the entire testing period (until the bell rings). After turning in the exam, a student may read another book or study for another exam.
- If a student has an excused absence during an exam, the parent/guardian must notify the Academic Vice Principal (831.724.5933 x 203; suarez@stfrancishigh.net) no later than 8:00 AM of the exam day. He will determine an alternate day and time for making up the exam.
- If a student has an unexcused absence during an exam, that student will receive a grade of zero for the exam.
- Students who notice an exam scheduling conflict must notify the Academic Vice Principal **at least two weeks in advance**. Exams needing to be rescheduled due to a scheduling conflict will occur at a date and time determined by the Academic Vice Principal.
